- B. It is important what is "called" over you when you are baptized!

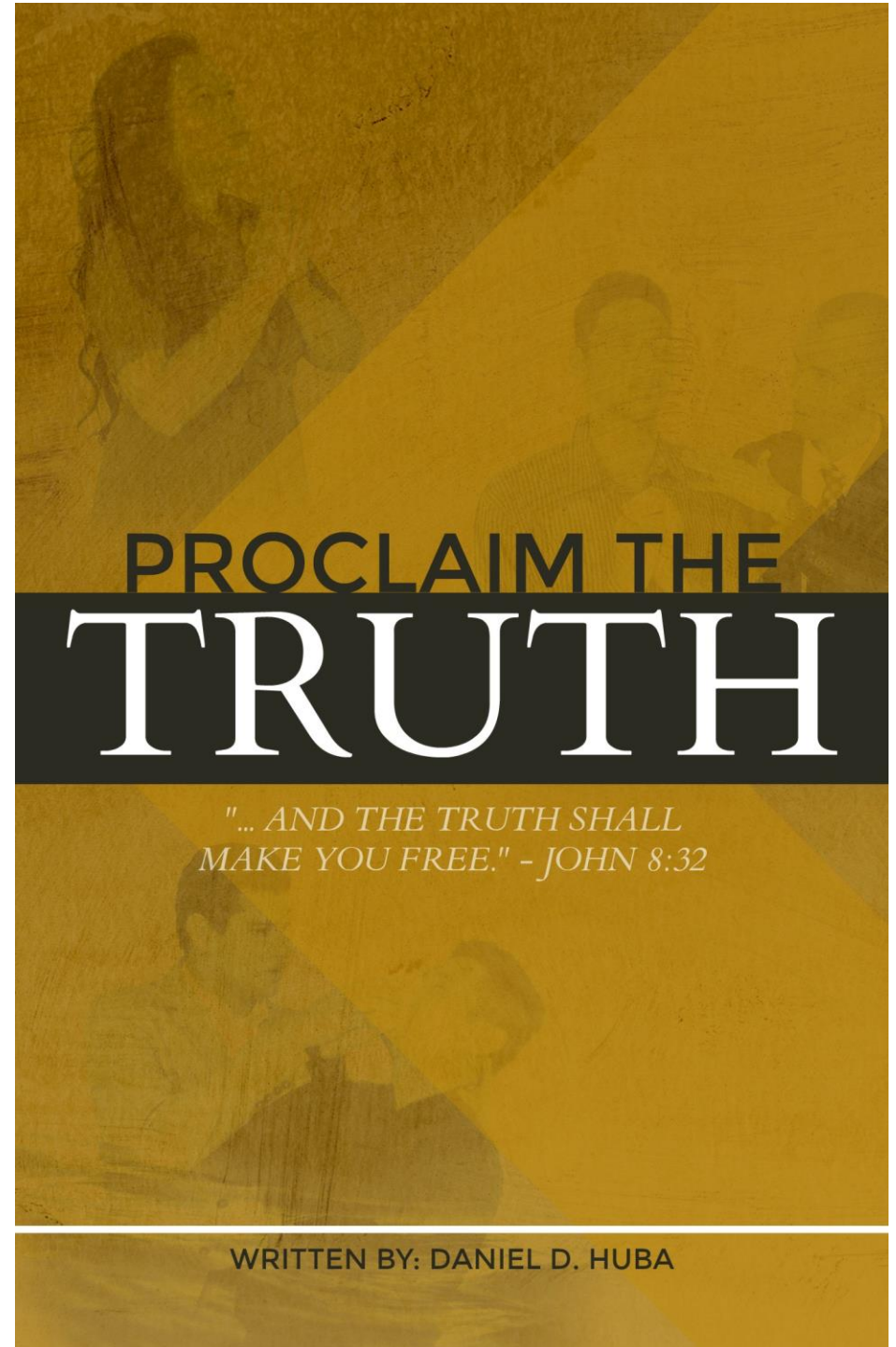
CONCLUSION:
